SPICE - STUDENTS PROJECT INNOVATION COMPETITION AND EXHIBITION

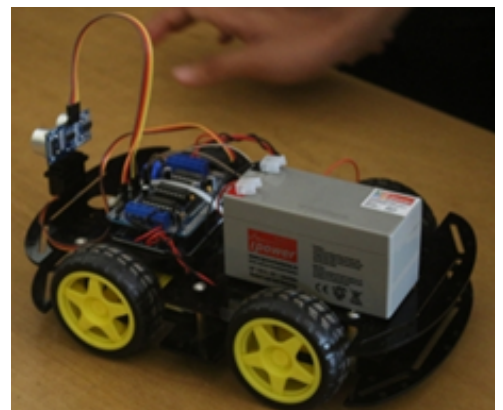
