Expert talk on Beyond Cyber security

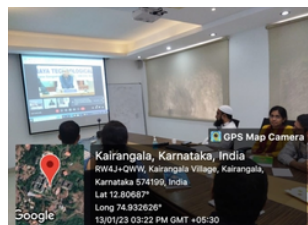
